Her love will remain in our hearts forever."



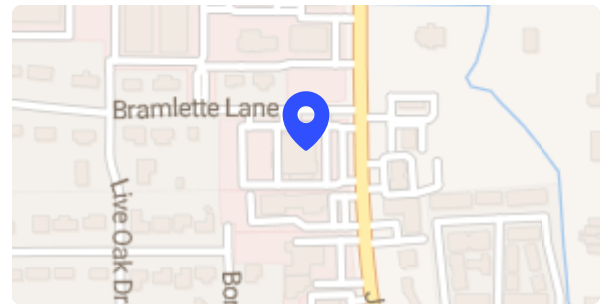
